Dear Friends in Music,

The ECCPA Organising Committee would like to invite you to be a sponsor, trader and or advertiser at the fourteenth ECCPA Conference presented by the Victorian Orff Schulwerk Association (VOSA) to be held on Saturday 21st and Sunday 22nd of August, 2010.

Over recent years the numbers of early childhood educators attending ECCPA has been steadily increasing. Last year we had 270 attending and, with attendees from around Australia, New Zealand and Asia. Enquires are already coming in for this year and we expect this to continue to grow.

The conference is advertised widely to those involved in any way with music and movement, and early childhood. Participants will encompass a number of professions including teachers (both primary and pre school), staff from crèches and day care centres as well as university students studying child care and primary teaching.

These participants represent a growing market for you as has been evidenced at the increasing popularity of our previous conferences. The benefits for you include:

I wish to:
